

An abstract of the rotation research is required for each rotation. With permission of student and mentor, these abstracts will be included in the rotation booklet descriptions for perusal by future students.

Abstract Instructions: The abstract is limited to 1 page. The title (in capital letters) should appear first, followed by the student's name, the mentor's name, and the departmental affiliation. Begin the text of the abstract on a new line with a 3 space indent, and single spacing throughout. The abstract should state the objectives of the rotation, briefly describe the methods used, summarize the results obtained, and state the conclusions. The last line of the abstract should state: **We give/do not give (*circle one*) permission to include this abstract in the rotation booklet.** Both the student and mentor should sign the bottom of the abstract. One copy of the abstract must be attached to the rotation evaluation form and both must be returned to the Neuroscience Program office within 5 days after the last day of class.
